SESSION TITLE: Zip Code Matters: Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention – Let’s Look at the Root Cause.

DESCRIPTION: The primary cause for childhood lead poisoning in Iowa is lead-based paint hazards. Using anecdotal evidence from people working in the field of Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention in Iowa, we will discuss where, geographically, are the most common areas for childhood lead poisoning in Iowa. Are there more rural or urban lead poisoning related environmental investigations? Why is that? What are the root causes leading to housing in homes with lead-based paint? Does socioeconomic status play a factor? How do we address these issues? What is needed to address the root cause? Are there any population pockets not being considered? Who can we partner with? How can we better present this data? What is needed to address the root cause? We will work on creating our own outlines for plans of action and create goals with actionable steps and measureable outcomes. Templates will be provided. Everyone will have different answers and different goals based on their position and location of employment, so sharing ideas will be beneficial, but ultimately unique plans will need to be made to accommodate each agency/ organization.
