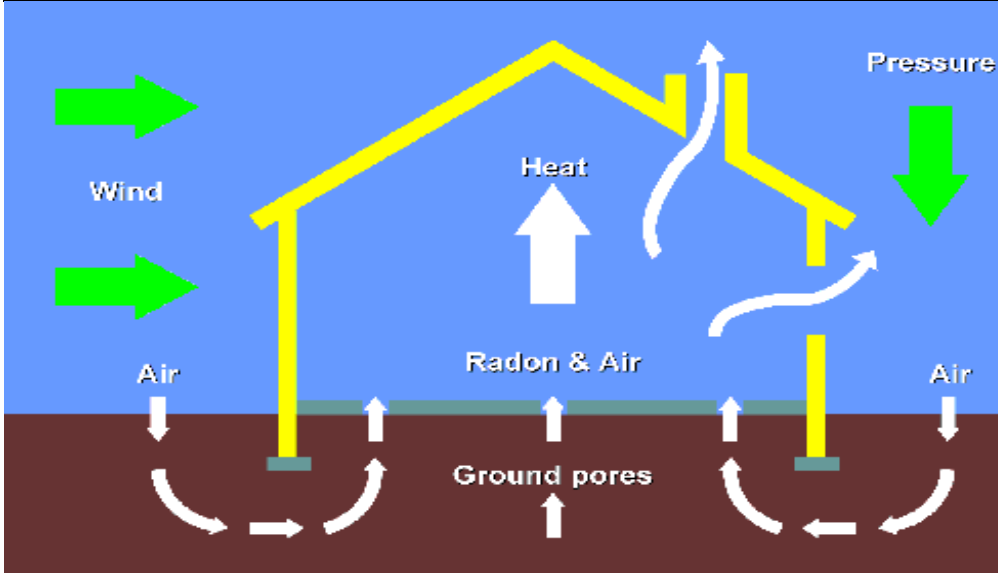




# 13<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL RADON STAKEHOLDERS' CONFERENCE MARCH 5, 2019
